PARADE INFORMATION - Parade starts 11:00 a.m.

1. NO ENTRY FEE if parade entry is received by Sept. 21, 2007. \$10.00 entry fee until Sept. 28, 2007. ENTRY NUMBERS WILL BE MAILED. Place numbers on right side of entry.
2. Entry deadline is September 28, 2007. Late entries may be accepted with a \$15.00 fee. NO EXCEPTIONS.
3. All horse entries will be pre-judged at 9:30 a.m.
4. Parade lineup is at 10:30 a.m. SHARP.
5. Parade starts at 11:00 a.m. SHARP.
6. JUNIOR ENTRY - 18 years old & under. SENIOR ENTRY - Over 18 years of age.
7. Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. All parade awards will be presented inside the VFW Post beginning with horse awards at approximately 2:00 p.m.
8. This is a forward motion parade. Perform the entire parade route. NO STOPPING AT JUDGES.
9. All units must maintain 25 feet from unit ahead.
10. Entrants leaving the parade before the designated end of parade will be disqualified.
11. Necessary parade categories will be added at the discretion of the Parade Committee.
12. Entrants must have complete control of vehicles and/or animals at all times.
13. The Parade Committee reserves the right to reject any entry not in keeping with the dignity of the parade.
14. Entrants driving a motorized vehicle must have a valid driver's license.
15. Nothing may be thrown from a parade entry.
